
Dear Judge Hellerstein:

We represent plaintiffs in the above-referenced action.

Mr. Dolinger has now submitted three separate letters to the Court. Consistent with Rules 2(A) and 2(B) of Your Honor's Individual Rules, we trust that Mr. Dolinger's letter motion for reconsideration "will not be accepted" and thus does not require further response from our office. Consistent with Rule 2(E), we trust that no response is required with respect to Mr. Dolinger's other letters sent yesterday and today and that they "will be returned unread."
