**MOTION TO EXTEND TIME IN
WHICH TO FILE PRETRIAL
MOTIONS**

COMES NOW the Defendant, Dejay Monson, by and through his attorney, Assistant Federal Public Defender, Michael F. Maloney, and moves the court for an extension of time within which to file pretrial motions. The Defendant would show the Court the following in support of this motion:

1. Pretrial motions were initially due on November 24, 2008.
2. Counsel has not had sufficient time to research the numerous legal issues presented by this case.
3. Defense counsel wishes to view the physical evidence prior to determining whether pretrial motions should be filed. Counsel are scheduled to review the physical evidence at the Burt County Sheriff's office during the week of December 1, 2008.
4. The Defendant has no objection to the requested extension and will file a waiver of speedy trial consistent with this request
5. Assistant United States Attorney Kim Bunjer has advised counsel that the government has no objection to the requested extension.

6. Counsel is requesting an extension until January 16, 2009 given the press of other cases including one case which will proceed to trial, United States v. Lamont Perkins in December and another likely trial in January, United States v. Devin Enriques.

WHEREFORE the Defendant prays the Court grant an extension of time to file pretrial motions to January 16, 2009.
