Dear Mr. Cox,

I mailed the attached documents by certified mail to the DEA in Washington in May of 2008 and I have the certified mail receipts showing they received them. Title 21 Code of Federal Regulations 1308.43(c) says the DEA will reply in a reasonable amount of time. I'm just wondering if there is a phone number I can call in Washington to get some kind of an estimate on how long it will take the DEA to respond to my petition. For example, if I filed a court case I would get a case number. I know the DEA doesn't handle petitions for rule making the same way as the courts handle court cases, but I would assume they have a clerk in charge of keeping track of who filed a petition and where it is at in the process. I was hoping I could get a phone number for that person, and, if possible, a name and mailing address for that person.

Of course, an email address would also be ideal, if you can get me one.
