

S-Amendment

1 Amend Senate Study Bill 1243 as follows:

2 1. Page 15, before line 3 by inserting:

3 Sec. 17. Section 124.204, subsection 4, paragraphs m and u, Code
4 2015, are amended by striking the paragraphs.

5 Sec. 18. Section 124.204, subsection 7, Code 2015, is amended by
6 striking the subsection.

7 Sec. 19. Section 124.206, subsection 7, Code 2015, is amended to
8 read as follows:

9 7. *Hallucinogenic substances.* Unless specifically excepted or un-
10 less listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or
11 preparation which contains any quantity of the following substances,
12 or, for purposes of paragraphs "a" and "b", which contains any of its
13 salts, isomers, or salts of isomers whenever the existence of such
14 salts, isomers, or salts of isomers is possible within the specific
15 chemical designation (for purposes of this paragraph only, the term
16 "isomer" includes the optical, positional, and geometric isomers):

17 a. ~~Marijuana when used for medicinal purposes pursuant to rules of~~
18 ~~the board.~~

19 b. Tetrahydrocannabinols, meaning tetrahydrocannabinols naturally
20 contained in a plant of the genus Cannabis (Cannabis plant) as well
21 as synthetic equivalents of the substances contained in the Canna-
22 bis plant, or in the resinous extractives of such plant, and synthet-
23 ic substances, derivatives, and their isomers with similar chemical
24 structure and pharmacological activity to those substances contained
25 in the plant, such as the following:

26 (1) 1 cis or trans tetrahydrocannabinol, and their optical iso-
27 mers.

28 (2) 6 cis or trans tetrahydrocannabinol, and their optical iso-
29 mers.

30 (3) 3,4 cis or trans tetrahydrocannabinol, and their optical iso-
31 mers. (Since nomenclature of these substances is not internationally
32 standardized, compounds of these structures, regardless of numerical
33 designation of atomic positions covered.)

34 ~~b.~~ c. Nabilone [another name for
35 nabilone: (+-) -
36 trans-3-(1,1-dimethylheptyl)-6,6a,7,8,10,10a-hexahydro-1-
37 hydroxy-6,6-dimethyl-9H-dibenzo[b,d]pyran-9-one].

38 Sec. 20. The Iowa Department of Public Health shall immediately
39 notify the U.S. Department of Justice that marijuana no longer meets
40 the statutory condition in Title 21 of the United States Code, Section
41 812(b)(1)(B), of a substance without accepted medical use in treatment
42 in the United States and must immediately be removed from Schedule I
43 by removing sections 1308.11(d)(23) and 1308.11(d)(31) from Title 21
44 of the Code of Federal Regulations as authorized by Title 21 of the
45 United States Code, Section 811(a)(2).
