CHAPTER 93

DRUGS

MARIJUANA—PENALTY FOR GROWING, SALE OR GIFT

(S. B. No. 409, by Senators Talbot, Lininger, Horn and Quiat)

AN ACT

PROHIBITING THE PRODUCTION, MANUFACTURE, SALE, GIFT, USE OR POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

Section 1. That Section 3 of Chapter 95 of the Session Laws of Colorado for the year 1927, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: Section Amended

Section 3. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Act shall upon a first conviction be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment; and upon a second or subsequent conviction of a violation of any of the provisions of this Act shall be deemed guilty of a felony and shall be punished by imprisonment in the state penitentiary for not less than one year nor more than five years.
