

Manufacturer - Tracks inventory throughout the MFR life cycle

- From plants ctract finished products
- Transports to dispensaries and labs / returns to MFR for disposal
- Product recall capability across the entire network
- Tracks employee actions like applying additives and moving plants
- Tracks plant weights and counts throughout process
- Tracks all waste through compost and disposal
- Sends alerts and notifications to department
- Physical inventory is checked against system inventory every 2 weeks

Dispensary - Tracks inventory throughout the DISP life cycle

- From receipt of goods from MFR to final sales
- Allows for patient and caregiver verification
- Allows for returns to MFR for variety of documented reasons
- Tracks all sales to the patient/caregiver level
- Ability to execute product recall from the manufacturer or department
- Tracks type and frequency of products sold across network
- Sends alerts and notifications to department
- Physical inventory is checked against system inventory every week

Patient and Caregiver Registration - Improved process and reporting

- Electronic process for application is enabled
- Ability to accept electronic checks, debit and credit cards
- Automated notification of approvals and status of application
- Physician lookup within the system
- Automated renewal process
- Overall more consumer-friendly than current system
