1 Amend [House File 2432](#) as follows:

12 follows:

13 7. *Hallucinogenic substances*. Unless
14 specifically excepted or unless listed
15 in another schedule, any material,
16 compound, mixture, or preparation which
17 contains any quantity of the following
18 substances, or, for purposes of paragraphs
19 "a" and "b", which contains any of its
20 salts, isomers, or salts of isomers
21 whenever the existence of such salts,
22 isomers, or salts of isomers is
23 possible within the specific chemical
24 designation (for purposes of this
25 paragraph only, the term "isomer" includes
26 the optical, positional, and geometric
27 isomers):

28 a. ~~Marijuana when used for medicinal~~
29 ~~purposes pursuant to rules of the~~

31 b. Tetrahydrocannabinols, meaning
32 tetrahydrocannabinols naturally
33 contained in a plant of the genus
34 Cannabis (Cannabis plant) as well as

35 synthetic equivalents of the substances
36 contained in the Cannabis plant, or in
37 the resinous extractives of such plant,
38 and synthetic substances, derivatives,
39 and their isomers with similar chemical
40 structure and pharmacological activity
41 to those substances contained in the
42 plant, such as the following:

43 (1) 1 cis or trans
44 tetrahydrocannabinol, and their optical
45 isomers.

46 (2) 6 cis or trans
47 tetrahydrocannabinol, and their optical
48 isomers.

50 tetrahydrocannabinol, and their optical
51 isomers. (Since nomenclature of these
52 substances is not internationally
53 standardized, compounds of these
54 structures, regardless of numerical
55 designation of atomic positions

9 Sec. 3. Section 124.206, subsection 7, Code 2015,
10 is amended to read as follows:

11 7. *Hallucinogenic substances.* Unless specifically
12 excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any
13 material, compound, mixture, or preparation which
14 contains any quantity of the following substances,
15 or, for purposes of paragraphs "a" and "b", which
16 contains any of its salts, isomers, or salts of isomers
17 whenever the existence of such salts, isomers, or salts
18 of isomers is possible within the specific chemical
19 designation (for purposes of this paragraph only, the
20 term "isomer" includes the optical, positional, and
21 geometric isomers):

22 a. Marijuana when used for medicinal purposes
23 pursuant to rules of the board.

24 b. Tetrahydrocannabinols, meaning
25 tetrahydrocannabinols naturally contained in a
26 plant of the genus Cannabis (Cannabis plant) as well
27 as synthetic equivalents of the substances contained
28 in the Cannabis plant, or in the resinous extractives
29 of such plant, and synthetic substances, derivatives,
30 and their isomers with similar chemical structure and
31 pharmacological activity to those substances contained
32 in the plant, such as the following:

33 (1) 1 cis or trans tetrahydrocannabinol, and their
34 optical isomers.

35 (2) 6 cis or trans tetrahydrocannabinol, and their
36 optical isomers.

37 (3) 3,4 cis or trans tetrahydrocannabinol, and
38 their optical isomers. (Since nomenclature of these
39 substances is not internationally standardized,
40 compounds of these structures, regardless of numerical
41 designation of atomic positions covered.)
