REPLY IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO DISMISS GOVERNOR SARAH HUCKABEE SANDERS AND ATTORNEY GENERAL TIM GRIFFIN OR ALTERNATIVE RENEWED MOTION TO DISMISS

Come Separate Defendants Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders and Attorney General Tim

Griffin, in their respective official capacities, and for their Reply in Support of their Motion to

Dismiss or alternative renewed Motion to Dismiss, state as follows:

1. Plaintiffs' Amended Complaint did not moot the Defendants' Motion to Dismiss as

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to Separate Defendants Governor Sanders and Attorney General Griffin.

2. The Amended Complaint did not change or add any of the allegations as against either defendant. *See* Compl. 5 ¶¶ 16-17 (ECF No. 1); *see also* Amend. Compl. 6 ¶¶ 16-17 (ECF No. 51).

3. Therefore, the original Motion to Dismiss as against these defendants should not be treated as moot.

4. Governor Sanders and Attorney General Griffin are entitled to sovereign immunity and should be dismissed as a matter of law. *Dig. Recognition Network, Inc. v. Hutchinson*, 803 F.3d 952, 956 (8th Cir. 2015) (citing *Pennhurst State Sch. & Hosp. v. Halderman*, 465 U.S. 89, 101 (1984)).

5. Neither defendant has any connection with the enforcement of Act 629, and therefore, their being named in the suit is an "impermissible attempt 'to make the state a party." *Dig. Recognition Network*, 803 F.3d at 960 (quoting *Ex Parte Young*, 209 U.S. 123, 157 (1908)); *see also Calzone v. Hawley*, 866 F.3d 866, 869 (8th Cir. 2017) (requiring "some connection to the enforcement of the challenged laws").

6. Because the Governor and Attorney General lack a connection with the enforcement of Act 629, just as in *Digital Recognition Network*, there is no "causal connection" between the injury and the defendant[s'] conduct." 803 F.3d at 957 (quoting *Lujan v. Defs. of Wildlife*, 504 U.S. 555, 560 (1992)). Thus, Plaintiffs lack standing to bring this lawsuit against the Governor and the Attorney General.

7. To the extent the Court does treat the original motion as moot, Governor Sanders and Attorney General Griffin renew their Motion to Dismiss for the same reasons as stated in the original motion.

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They incorporate by reference the arguments and authorities as raised in Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (ECF No. 38) as if set for herein word for word. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 10(c).

CONCLUSION

For the above-stated reasons, dismissal of Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders and Attorney General Tim Griffin is warranted at this time based on sovereign immunity and lack of standing as a matter of law.
